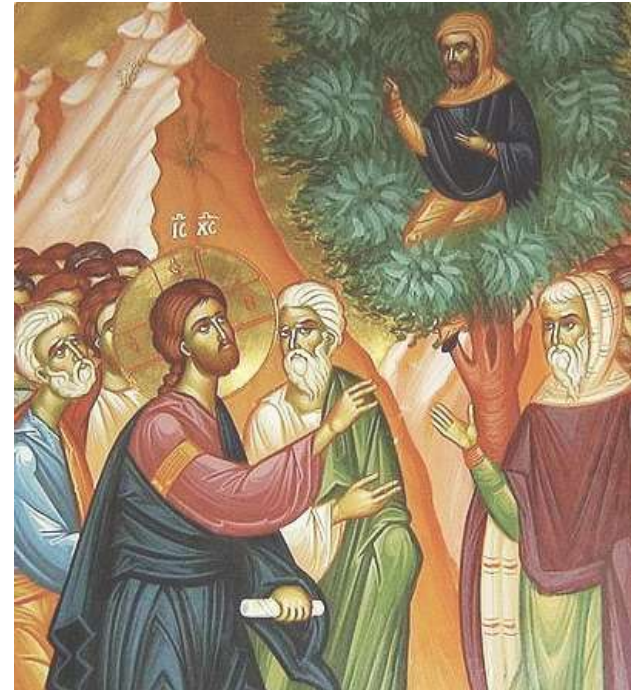

GREETING  
*The celebrant greets the candidates and invites them forward with their sponsors.*

OPENING DIALOGUE *with the CANDIDATES*  
*The candidates are called forward and questioned.*

AFFIRMATION *by the SPONSORS and ASSEMBLY*  
*The celebrant addresses the sponsors and assembly and questions their  
preparedness to support the candidates on their journey of initiation.*  
*All respond: **We are.***

ACCLAMATION  
  
We praise you, Lord, and we bless you.

SIGNING *of the CATECHUMENS and the CANDIDATES with the CROSS  
on the FOREHEAD and OTHER SENSES*  
*The celebrant traces the sign of the cross on the forehead, ears,  
eyes, lips, breast, shoulders, hands and feet of the candidates.*

ACCLAMATION *after each SIGNING*  
  
Glo-ry and praise to you, Lord Je-sus Christ.
