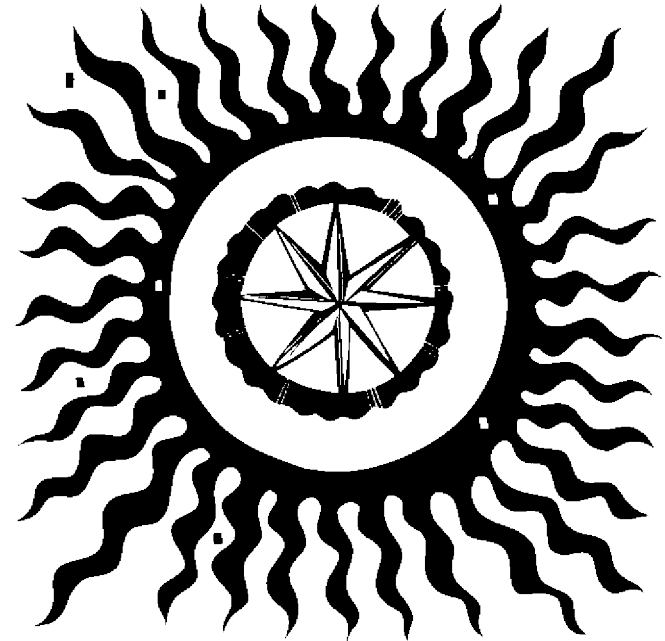

on the FOREHEAD *and* OTHER SENSES

*The celebrant traces the sign of the cross on the forehead, ears,
eyes, lips, breast, shoulders, hands and feet of the candidates.*
