I did not restrain my lips, as you, O LORD, know. *R*

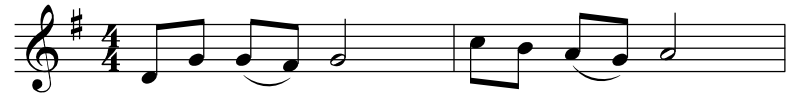
