### A FESTIVAL of ADVENT LESSONS *and* CAROLS

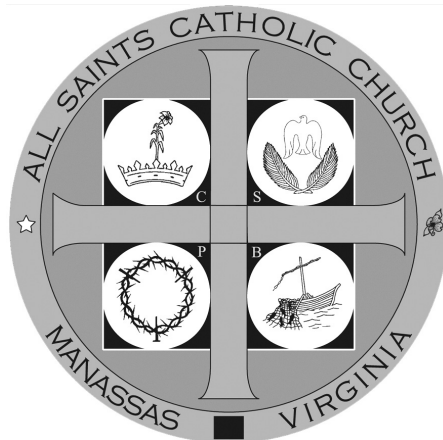
